THE FULLERTON WATERBOAT HOUSE

- Property Name:** The Fullerton Waterboat House [富丽敦船屋]
- Address:** No. 3 Fullerton Road, Singapore 049323
- Positioning:** An All-day waterfront dining and retail destination, with roof top and viewing decks offering panoramic views of Marina Bay as well as the central business and historic civic districts.
- Background:** The Fullerton Waterboat House was built in 1919 and was designed by the renowned architectural firm, Swan & Maclaren. In the past, it supplied water, which was ferried by waterboats to the ships anchored offshore. It is a unique and historical building designed in the Art Deco style with an elegantly curved facade and curved balconies. The glass enclosed lookout deck on top of the building and circular windows give the building its nautical image. The building was given conservation status on 21 March 2002.
